Mihtatakaw Sipi School is currently seeking to recruit **TWO** elders from the DCN to serve as community engagement consultants. The consultants are to be aware and knowledgeable of traditional early childhood education and care practices in Driftpile Cree Nation. This engagement is planned for a two day consultation process. The incumbents will review and provide local traditional insight and input towards the Mihtatakaw Sipi School Early Childhood Curriculum Framework.

LOCATION: Mihtatakaw Sipi School, Driftpile Cree Nation

DURATION: 2 days (August 11th & 12th 2021), 9:00 am-3:30 pm

HONORARIUM: \$150/day with lunch, beverages, and snacks provided.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Be a Driftpile Cree Nation Elder (65+)
- Knowledge of Driftpile culture, traditions, history, and issues.
- Parenting and childcare experience.

COMPETENCIES:

- Community awareness and understanding - ability to identify the needs and wants of the community regarding early childhood education and care.
- Project strategy awareness - demonstrates and promotes a personal understanding of and appreciation for the vision and values guiding the curriculum framework. Ability to visualize future direction and provide input regarding strategies, planning, and action towards achieving visions and goals.
- Communication/interpersonal skills - able to listen, secure information, and communicate relevant perspectives. Ability to cooperate and work in in a team setting to achieve the desired results.
- Problem solving - ability to identify an issue and provide relevant information, provide possible alternatives/solutions, and evaluate response relevance.
